

# Town of Elmer City

## Resolution R5-2024

*A Resolution Placing Burn Restrictions within the Incorporated Town of Elmer City, Washington.*

**WHEREAS**, dry summer weather provides for high fire conditions and the potential for large and catastrophic fires that may be a treat to life, damage or destruction to homes, businesses, and natural resources; and

**WHEREAS**, Okanogan County Commissioners approved Resolution 73-2024 restricting burning within the unincorporated area of Okanogan County; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council and the Mayor have determined a need to reduce the likelihood of human caused wildfires; and

**WHEREAS**, a burn restriction prohibits **ALL** field, pile, rubbish, slash, and yard vegetation burning within the city limits of the Town of Elmer City; and

**WHEREAS**, setting off fireworks are illegal in the Town of Elmer City, per town code; and

**WHEREAS**, recreational fires are allowed if used for pleasure, cooking, warmth, or similar purpose; and

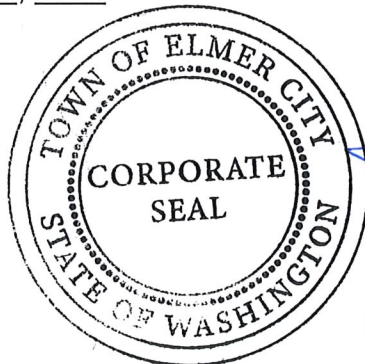
**WHEREAS**, when high fire conditions exist ALL outdoor burning shall be prohibited, including recreational fires; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the restrictions of burning with City limits will be in effect starting June 15, 2024 and will continue thru October 15, 2024; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Town of Elmer City, shall adhere to Okanogan County Resolution 73-2024, CCT burning codes and Washington State burning restrictions; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council for the Town of Elmer City, Washington this attached Resolution is hereby adopted.
